Ocean Gem finished the Pittwater to Paradise Yacht Race at approximately 0001(EST) on 07/01/2019.</li> <li>2. The first Warning signal for the Sail Paradise Regatta was not before 1055 hrs on 06/01/2019.</li> <li>3. The Sail Paradise NOR 14.2 states To be eligible to win the Pittwater to Paradise Regatta Perpetual Trophy, a boat must have competed in the Pittwater to Paradise Yacht Race on 2nd January, and the Sail Paradise Regatta.</li> <li>4. Ocean Gem was unable to start Races 1 and 2 of the Sail Paradise Regatta because she was still racing and had not finished the Pittwater to Paradise Yacht Race.</li> </ol> <p><b>CONCLUSIONS</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. There was an omission of the Race Committee by not including a Time Limit or provision for TLE scoring in the Pittwater to Paradise NOR or SI.</li> <li>2. Through no fault of her own Ocean Gem's score was made significantly worse in the Sail Paradise Regatta.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Ocean Gem is to be scored Average Points in Races 1 and 2 for all races up to and including the second last day of the Sail Paradise Regatta.</li> <li>2. Stealth was also effected the same as Ocean Gem and is granted redress as above for Races 1 &amp; 2.</li> </ol>	RRS 62, Sail Paradise NOR 14.2, A10
